

## Terms of Use

### **General Information**

This platform is owned and operated by the Government of Togo.

Access to and browsing of this platform are voluntary and free of charge and automatically confer upon the interested party the status

of “User” (hereinafter, “User,” “you”).

The status of “User” implies full and unconditional acceptance of these Terms of Use (TOU). Therefore, we recommend that you carefully read the following TOU before using this platform. If you do not agree to be bound by these TOU, you will not be able to use the features of this platform.

These Terms of Use may be updated at any time and without notice to the user in order to comply with applicable laws and regulations in Togo. Updates may occur in response to changes in the services or features offered by this platform. In the event of an update, the new Terms of Use shall take effect upon their publication on the platform.
